- Measure our safety performance, share trends and results to drive continual improvement.
- Undertake annual assessments of policies, procedures, method statements, risk assessments, and COSHH assessments.
- Competency check all our workforce to ensure they have the mandatory skills, knowledge, and training.
- Provide occupational health assessments for our workforce to ensure they are fit for work.
- Regularly test and review our emergency procedures for fire evacuation and first aid.
- Ensure our working environment support health and safety practices including safe access and egress of fleet and plant.

Lisa Kerford Company Managing Director takes overall responsibility and therefore is ultimately responsible for Health, Safety, Quality and Environmental Management within the company and as such is responsible for formulating and implementing the policy and ensuring it is maintained.
