If you feel the need to cough or sneeze, do so into a tissue which should then be placed into a suitable bin, after doing so wash your hands. If you do not have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your elbow crease. Keep all meeting room windows open to ensure ventilation is sufficient. Keep away from people who are noticeably ill – coughing, sneezing etc. Be aware of the symptoms of covid-19 – a persistent dry cough and a high temperature.
