Maternity and Adoption Leave and Pay

Parents who qualify will be entitled to up to 52 weeks maternity leave and to up to 39 weeks Statutory Maternity Pay (SMP)

Paternity Leave and Pay

The first few weeks after welcoming your new family member is such an important time and we want to ensure that you get the opportunity to enjoy the time as a family. We therefore offer 2 week paternity leave and pay, providing qualifying criteria are met.

Shared Parental Leave

Shared parental leave is a reasonably new government incentive, where you can share up to 50 weeks of leave and up to 37 weeks of pay between both parents. Aptus is happy to support this legislation and further information can be found at https://www.gov.uk/shared-parental-leave-and-pay

Flexible working

All our colleagues can request flexible working, which may include remote working, part time hours or changing start and finish times. One request can be submitted per year and all requests will be considered, but business needs must always be taken in to account before any agreement is met. Where we will try to accommodate requests where it is possible, some may unfortunately be rejected for valid reasons.

Tax Free Childcare

Development

However, we don't just ensure that our people have the basics, we go above and beyond to ensure that everyone is highly trained to ensure that we provide the excellent customer service that our clients expect from Aptus.



Investing In The Team

In the year 2020-2021, Aptus delivered **5360** hours of training across **766** training courses over the business. In the same year, there was also **9** colleagues working towards an Apprenticeship, either a specialist Craft Apprenticeship or a Business Administration Apprenticeship. In 2021-22 we already have **28** colleagues on enhanced leadership and management training alongside **25** people who are signed up to 5 year development plans.
